

Arlene's Scarf



Size 7 needles. Acrylic worsted (#4) yarn – works well with Caron One Pound solid colors.

Finished size should be 7" wide x 9" tall.

Cast on 30 (multiple of 4 plus 2) stitches. Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the beginning.

K1 P1 repeat between * to the end of the first seed stitch row.

P1 K1 repeat between * to the end of the second seed stitch row.

Pattern:

All rows: (K2 K1b P1) K2 – repeat inside the parentheses until two stitches from the end.

Do 6 rows in pattern. STOP! Check the width to make sure it is 7". If not, change needle size to get the appropriate width.

Repeat pattern until one row short of 9" then bind off in pattern. Or stop two rows short of 9" and bind add two seed stitch rows, binding off in row 2. The example in the picture ended with two seed stitch rows.

Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the end.

Now, knit another one using this or a different pattern since having two blocks in the same color is great for making shawls!

Knitting abbreviations:

K: Knit | P: Purl | K1b – Knit through the back of the stitch instead of through the front.
