



Modified knitting pattern for making the embroidery process easier for M (L) gloves.

Evil Eye Gloves¹

For March for Our Lives – March 24, 2018



Right Glove

Cast on 32 (36) Stitches in Main Color (MC) on size 8 needles. Leave a long tail for seaming. Do 2 rows in seed stitch, then knit 4 rows. Do 26 rows in stockinette stitch.

Row 27: K6 (7) MC, K7 white carrying MC behind, then K19 (22) MC

Row 28: P18 (21) MC, P9 white carrying MC behind, then P5 (6) MC

Row 29: K4 (5) MC, K11 white carrying MC behind, then K17 (20) MC

Row 30: P16 (19) MC, P13 white carrying MC behind, then P3 (4) MC

Row 31: K3 (4) MC, K13 white carrying MC behind, then K16 (19) MC

Row 32: P16 (19) MC, P13 white carrying MC behind, then P3 (4) MC

Row 33: K4 (5) MC, K11 white carrying MC behind, then K17 (20) MC

Row 34: P18 (21) MC, P9 white carrying MC behind, then P5 (6) MC

Row 35: K6 (7) MC, K7 white carrying MC behind, then K19 (22) MC

Row 36: P32 (36) MC

Continue in stockinette stitch until glove measures 7.5 inches. Knit 4 rows, then 2 rows of seed stitch, binding off in last row and leaving a tail.



Left Glove

Cast on 32 (36) Stitches in Main Color (MC) on size 8 needles. Leave a long tail for seaming. Do 2 rows in seed stitch, then knit 4 rows. Do 26 rows in stockinette stitch.

Row 27: K19 (22) MC, K7 white carrying MC behind, then K6 (7) MC

Row 28: P5 (6) MC, P9 white carrying MC behind, then P18 (21) MC

Row 29: K17 (20) MC, K11 white carrying MC behind, then K4 (5) MC

Row 30: P3 (4) MC, P13 white carrying MC behind, then P16 (19) MC

Row 31: K16 (19) MC, K13 white carrying MC behind, then K3 (4) MC

Row 32: P3 (4) MC, P13 white carrying MC behind, then P16 (19) MC

Row 33: K17 (20) MC, K11 white carrying MC behind, then K4 (5) MC

Row 34: P5 (6) MC, P9 white carrying MC behind, then P18 (21) MC

Row 35: K19 (22) MC, K7 white carrying MC behind, then K6 (7) MC

Row 36: P32 (36) MC

Continue in stockinette stitch until glove measures 7.5 inches. Knit 4 rows, then 2 rows of seed stitch, binding off in last row and leaving a tail.

Embroidery

With Black yarn, embroider the outline of the eye and eyelashes using stem stitch. With Blue, embroider the iris of the eye using a type of blanket stitch that forms a circle.

Finishing

Starting at the bottom of each glove, stitch side to 3 ½ inch mark. Leave 2 inch opening for thumb. Stitch down from top 2 inches.

Guage

18 stitches and 26 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch
