

## Lacy Circles<sup>1</sup>



Size 7 needles. Acrylic worsted (#4) yarn – works well with Caron One Pound solid colors.

Finished size should be 7" wide x 9" tall.

Cast on 30 stitches. Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the beginning.

\*K1 P1\* repeat between \* to the end of the row (seed stitch).

### **Pattern set:**

Row 1 (wrong side) and all uneven number rows: P

Row 2: \*K2, yo (yarn over), K1, K2tog (knit two together), K2tog, K1, yo, K2\* repeat between \* three times.

Row 4: \*K3, yo, K2tog, K2tog, yo, K3\* repeat between \* three times.

Row 6: \*K2tog, K1, yo, K4, yo, K1, K2tog\* repeat between \* three times.

Row 8: \*K2tog, yo, K6, yo, K2tog\* repeat between \* three times.

STOP! Check the width to make sure it is 7". If not, change needle size to get the appropriate width.

Repeat rows 1-8 for a total of 6 complete pattern sets.

STOP! Check the length to make sure it will not exceed 9". Add one more complete or a partial pattern set to adjust the final length while allowing room for two final seed stitch rows.

Bind off in an odd row while substituting seed stitch for the purl stitches.

Be sure to leave an 18" tail at the end.

Now, knit another one since having two blocks in the same color and pattern is great for making shawls!

**Knitting abbreviations:**

K: Knit | P: Purl
